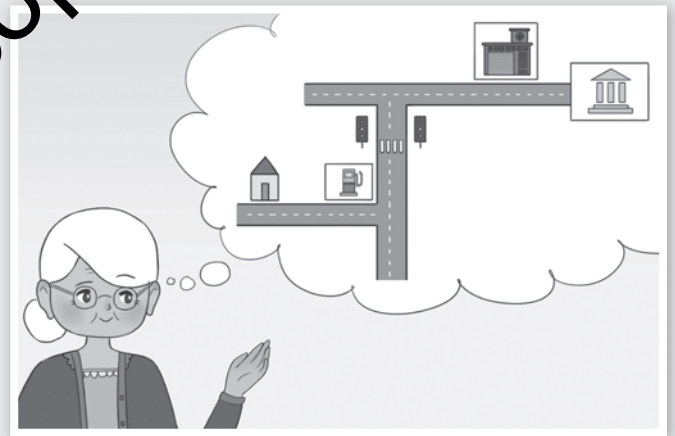
Learning to Help, Helping to Learn

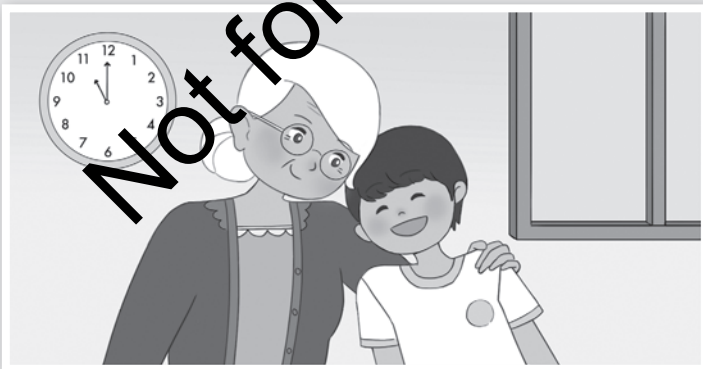

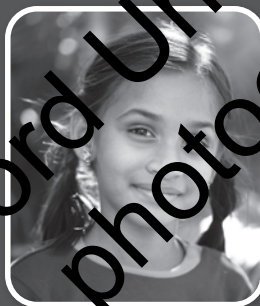

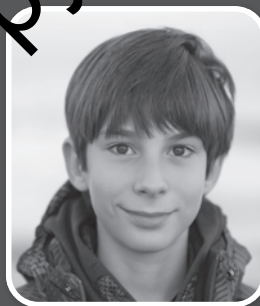
